1. BHE1 Invitational Tournament Executives:

2. Game Format:

- A. 3 15-minute run time periods.
- B. One 5-minute warmup per game.
- C. 1 time-out per game.
- D. Last 2 minutes of third period stop time if score differential is 3 goals or less.
- E. If tied, 5 minute straight time 3-on-3 overtime. No timeouts in overtime.
- F. If tied after overtime period, 1-player sudden death shootout. All players must shoot before taking a second shot.

3. Rules & Regulations:

- A. Unless otherwise specified, all play will be governed by the official CBHA rulebook.
- B. Team placement in various divisions will be determined by the BHE1 Minor tournament directors.
- C. All players must play at least 1 round robin game in order to participate in playoff games.
- D. Timekeepers are officials too and can report major or match penalties, should they witness it, to the officials presiding over the game. If necessary, the timekeeper will assist the officials in writing the incident report post-game.
- E. Teams must wear matching uniforms/jerseys these uniforms should all be the same base color .
- F. Teams are allowed to have a maximum of 5 coaches on the bench. The coach's name must be listed on the team's roster for the game.
- G. FANS Any inappropriate behaviour by fans towards players and officials will not be tolerated. Unruly fans will be asked to leave the soccer center immediately. Multiple incidents will result in the team being suspended from the tournament.
- H. Rosters are to be submitted into BHE1 Minor no later than Thursday, May 15, 2025.
- I. Absolutely no sub players at any time. Players can only play on one team; emergency goalies may be used from within the Tournament teams only on an if needed basis and must be approved by Tournament Committee.





4. Team Standings:

- A. Round robin games: Regulation Win = 3 Points; Overtime & Shootout win = 2 Points; Overtime or Shootout Loss = 1 Point; Loss = 0 Points.
- B. If teams are tied in the standings after all round robin games have been played the tie will be broken as follows:
 - 1: Most regulation wins
 - 2: Most wins
 - 3: Head-to-head result
 - 4: Goals for/against differential
 - 5: Least PIM

5. Playoffs:

- A. **4 Team Division:** 1 vs. 4 2 vs. 3 Semi Final. Winners play in A Final
- B. 6 Team Division: Semi Final: Div A1 vs. Div B2. Div B1 vs. Div A2. Winners play in A Final. 3rd place teams in A and B, will play in a Consolation Game. Subject to change at Tournament Committee's discretion.
- C. **For Semi Final games tied at the end of regulation time**, a 5 minute 3-on-3 overtime period will be played. If tied at the end of overtime a 3-player sudden death shoot-out will occur. Shoot-out format is best of three shooters, if still tied, sudden death shoot-out. All players must shoot prior to taking a second shot. Visiting team shoots first.
- D. **Suspensions are listed below.** Any player incurring a suspension and will not be eligible to play in the tournament, or BHE1 Minor League, until the suspension is served in full.
- E. **Equipment:** <u>All player equipment must be CSA approved</u>. The BHE1 Minor Executive reserves the right to approve all street hockey gear for goalies as long as it has not been altered from its original state. CSA approved helmets are mandatory for players and officials.

- Officials include all BHE1 Minor Tournament Directors, all referees and all timekeepers.

- Players who accumulate two or more suspensions will be suspended for the remainder of the tournament and may also be suspended from BHE1 Minor League play.
- Actions deemed serious enough to bring in the Soccer Centre staff may/will result in Soccer Centre Discipline that is above and beyond BHE1 Minor.
- All suspensions are automatic and the player must sit out the next game(s). Players who are suspended and attempt to play will be suspended for the remainder of the tournament. Team reps who allow suspended player(s) to play will also be suspended for the remainder of the tournament.
- All above suspensions are guidelines only and the BHE1 Minor Tournament Directors reserve the right to increase the suspensions on a "per case" basis.
- Suspensions outstanding once a team is eliminated from play will be considered on a "per case" basis and said suspension(s) may carry over into Winter season league play.
